Preliminary Comments and Concerns regarding Division One:

- 1. Time is running out. We need to define who is going to take the ADSO-NS Staff leadership in this AOR. There are many problems to be resolved before the OPFACS get back in the water and we have to get started right away resolving them.
- 2. There are 222 PATONs identified for the SWH AOR on the PATON System and are listed on the PATON spreadsheet. 75 were verified in 2010 leaving 167 to be verified in 2011. Many are in Northern Maine where there are fewer AVs and OPFACS. There are 9 bridges in Div. 1.
- 3. 99 Non-Permitted have been identified and listed on the PATON spreadsheet. There is a lot of work done to identify the owners and have them submit PATON applications to DPW 1. Approximately 50% of the 368 PATONs identified are lacking owner information. This is a winter project.
- 4. There are 46 PATONs that were on the I-ATONIS list back in February 2010 that are currently not listed in the PATON System. These aids have to be researched as to what happened to them. Are they established aids or have they been formally deleted by DPW 1. This also is a winter project.
- 5. There are 19 AVs in Division 1. 7 are going into REYR in 2011 and I is ill, leaving only 11 currently qualified AVs in Division 1.
- 6. We need to recruit more AVs and train them before May, 2011 in Division 1.

<u>Preliminary Comments and Concerns regarding Division</u> TWO:

- 1. There are 237 PATONs identified in the South Portland AOR on the PATON System and are listed on the PATON spreadsheet. 234 were verified in 2010 leaving 32 to be verified in 2011. There are 46 bridges in Div. 2. Some still need photos and others have never been reported. We need to focus on getting all the bridges surveyed in 2011. The estimated PATON verification plan for 2011 is 80 PATONS. This does not include the many non-permitted aids that will be identified and reported.
- 2. 12 Non-Permitted have been identified and listed on the PATON spreadsheet. The owners need to be identified the owners and have them submit PATON applications to DPW 1. Approximately 6% of the 256 PATONs identified are lacking owner information. This is a winter project.
- 3. There are 17 PATONs that were on the I-ATONIS list back in February 2010 that are currently not listed in the PATON System. These aids have to be researched as to what happened to them. Are they established aids or have they been formally deleted by DPW 1. This also is a winter project.
- **4.** There are 39 AVs in Division 2. 21 are going into REYR in 2011, leaving only 18 currently qualified AVs in Division 2.
- 5. We need to survey the AVs going into REYR and retrain them before May, 2011 in Division 2 to find out whether they plan to become active during 2011.
- **6.** A major part of the 2011 plan must be to document the many Aquaculture PATONs that have been deployed as non-permitted throughout the Division. This activity should add many non-permitted PATONs to the spreadsheet schedule.
- 7. We also need to sort out the Lamprey River PATONs that had no identifying marks and numbers when verified. There has to be a meeting with the owners to resolve these issues. There are tributaries off the Lamprey River that are in the same condition.

Preliminary Comments and Concerns regarding ANT Boston AOR:

- 1. There are five Auxiliary Division within the ANT Boston AOR Div 3 Newburyport, Division 4 North Shore, Division 5 Boston, Division 9 Connecticut River and Division 12 South Shore.
- 2. There are **494** PATONs identified in the ANT Boston AOR on the PATON System and are listed on the PATON spreadsheet. **455** were verified in 2010 leaving **81** to be verified in 2011. There are 89 bridges in this AOR. The estimated PATPN verification plan for 2011 is 165 PATONs.
- 3. 36 Non-Permitted have been identified and listed on the PATON spreadsheet. The owners need to be identified the owners and have them submit PATON applications to DPW 1. Approximately 4% of the 536 PATONs identified are lacking owner information. This is a winter project.
- **4.** There are **6** PATONs that were on the I-ATONIS list back in February 2010 that are currently not listed in the PATON System. These aids have to be researched as to what happened to them. Are they established aids or have they been formally deleted by DPW 1. This also is a winter project.
- 5. There are 32 AVs in ANT Boston. 12 are going into REYR in 2011, leaving only 20 currently qualified AVs. Much verification support came from outside the AOR in 2010.
- 6. We need to survey the AVs going into REYR and retrain them before May, 2011 to find out whether they plan to become active during 2011. We need to continue to recruit additional AVs for this AOR.

Preliminary Comments and Concerns regarding ANT Woods Hole AOR:

- 1. There are two Auxiliary Divisions within the Woods Hole AOR Division 11 on the Cape itself and Division 6 in Buzzards Bay.
- 2. There are **1,337** PATONs identified on the PATON System and are listed on the PATON spreadsheet. **1,078** were verified in 2010 leaving **259** to be verified in 2011. The estimated PATON verification plan for 2011 is **446** PATONS. There are **20** bridges in this AOR.
- 3. 25 Non-Permitted have been identified and listed on the PATON spreadsheet. The owners need to be identified the owners and have them submit PATON applications to DPW 1. Approximately 2% of the 1,406 PATONs identified are lacking owner information. This is a winter project.
- **4.** There are **44** PATONs that were on the I-ATONIS list back in February 2010 that are currently not listed in the PATON System. These aids have to be researched as to what happened to them. Are they established aids or have they been formally deleted by DPW 1. This also is a winter project.
- **5**. There are 50 AVs in ANT Woods Hole. 14 are going into REYR in 2011, leaving 36 currently qualified AVs.
- 6. We need to survey the AVs going into REYR and retrain them before May, 2011 to find out whether they plan to become active during 2011. We need to continue to recruit additional AVs for this AOR.
- 7. The standard planning tasks listed in Section VII below must be accomplished and planned.

Section VII MAJOR NAVIGATION SYSTEMS TEAM TASKS TO BE COMPLETED IN PREPARATION FOR THE 2011 SEASON

- 1. <u>Define the PATONs that will be verified during 2011.</u> The goal is to verify one-third of the PATONs. This one-third should include any PATONs that weren't verified in 2010 as a top priority. AVs should be alert for discrepant PATONs and for PATONs that were reported as discrepant in 2010 that are still discrepant. A spreadsheet schedule will be supplied for this purpose.
- 2. Decide how to assign responsibility for the verification of PATONs and Bridges within each CG ANT AOR. The PATON System now has the capability for identifying PATON with Divisions, Flotillas or Patrol Areas. Some CG ANT AORs break out perfectly with Flotillas. Others must be defined by PATROL Areas. Each NS TEAM must decide how the PATONs will be managed and what PATONs and Bridges will be assigned to each sub-grouping. Flotillas with no NS resources trained AVs and OPFACS obviously cannot be assigned PATONs and Bridges.

3. Define the CG ANT Auxiliary Liaisons(s) for your AOR.

- a. These are the AVs who will interface with the CG ANT.
- b. All manual non permitted PATON reports and PATON discrepancy photographs will be forwarded to the CG ANT through these assignees.
- 4. Identify the AVs who assist at each CG ANT.

5. Define the Urgent Report Procedure for your CG ANT.

- a. Define the phone numbers, fax numbers and/or e-mail addresses along with the procedures for the CG ANT for reporting observed Critical ATON or PATON Discrepancies to the Coast Guard.
- b. BRIDGE reports are made through the on-line Bridge Reporting System. Critical Bridge Reports are made to the DSO-NS 013 at 978-363-3023 or FrankJLarkin@verizon.net/

6. Review the AV List for your AOR.

- a. Identify whether an AV in REYR plans to be active in the program in 2011.
- b. Identify the BC Status of each active AV—Boat Crew or Coxswain qualified.
- c. Identify whether the AV owns an OPFAC.

- d. Identify the AOR where each AV normally works. AVs can be assigned to CG ANT AORs similar to PATONs on the PATON System.
- e. A spreadsheet will be sent listing all of the AVs and their current status.

7. <u>Identify and report all of the potential problems in each AOR, such as:</u>

- a. Insufficient AVs to do the job.
- b. Lack of OPFACS in your AOR.
- c. Charts were provided last year. Most of these charts are still current. Work with your CG ANTs to get any additional charts that you may need for 2011.
- d. AVs should download the section of the Light List and Coast Pilot for their AOR. Wait until the 2011 Light List is published.
- e. Report all other issues that you feel should be addressed to the DSO-NS 013'

8. Each CG ANT AOR will need to have a NS training workshop in their AOR in 2011.

- a. The overall CG ANT Plan for the AOR will be reviewed.
- b. <u>The upgrades to the PATON System must be reviewed.</u> You need an Internet connection for this presentation.
- c. <u>The Upgrades to the BRIDGE System must be reviewed</u>. You need an Internet connection to make this presentation.
- d. Ideally, it would be great if we could get commitments from specific AVS for individual PATONs and Bridges.
- e. I would like to receive NS Workshop dates as soon as possible so I can plan my schedule. If you let this training go too late in the season, you will have many conflicts with Operations training schedules and OPFAC preparation time.
- f. There will be AVs available at the April Awards Conference to do check off sand to train the AVs in some of their missing tasks.

9. Off Shore PATONs to be Verified by AUX AIR

- a. Identify the Off Shore PATON List with Lat/Long.
- b. Determine which PATONs can be verified by AUXAIR.
- c. Write a brief policy statement for the PATON Guide.
- d. Assign the Off Shore Aids to AUXAIR.
- e. Determine the disposition of the off-shore PATONs that are beyond the limits of the AUXAIR flight limits.
