August 15, 2013 PATON / Bridge Progress Report

We have only reported 31.8 % of the scheduled PATONs to date. We have 576 PATONs left to verify. Check out your Patrol Area schedule and prepare a plan to wrap it up in the next few weeks.

Our northern Maine AVs have their job cut out for them. We are working on some plans for the northern PATONs that have little or no AV coverage and support. There are only three lateral aids in that area that are scheduled this year. The rest of the PATONs are located at three aquacultural facilities.

DIVISION 1 The remaining PATONs and 1 Bridge are located in the northern areas where that are no AVs and facilities. Nancy Plunkett is trying to develop a plan to handle them. We may have to resort to having the owners submit status reports on their own aids.

DIVISION 2 We not received much response so far this year from the Southern Maine AVs. Only 4 bridges and 4 PATONs have been reported to date this year. Our AVs need to step up and deal with this AOR or else the Coast Guard will have to perform these verifications. These 115 PATONs and 43 Bridges are a large percentage of the First Northern program this year.

FOR YOUR INFORMATION:

Here are the rules for identifying activity in First Northern:

Your PATON and Bridge reports don't count until you hit the SUBMIT button on a 7054 AV Verification Report.

- This transmits your 7054 AV Verification Report to the Coast Guard and the PATON owner.
- Only current and qualified AVs may submit PATON and Bridge reports. This is controlled by access code.

Your Auxiliary PATON and Bridge activity is not recorded in AUXDATA until you submit a 7030 Activity Report individual to your IS Officer and they enter the information into the AUXDATA System.

- AVs showing in **red** on the previous AV Report reflect this condition.
- Your submitted and recorded AUXDATA numbers are used to determine your AV Currency and Qualification and annual awards. AVs showing in **blue** on the above list have met these requirements for 2013.

- At the moment, only 50 AVs out of 150 have met the annual requirement of submission of two PATON, Bridge or ATON discrepancy reports to the Coast Guard.
- There has been much AUXDATA activity reported for Auxiliarists who are not AV qualified. This information will be ignored for qualifications and awards.
- Also, there was a lot of unscheduled PATONs reported that were watching properly. This causes extra work for both the AV and the ANT. And. It doesn't reduce the Auxiliary commitment to verify one-third of the PATONs. Some PATONs may not be verified within their three year commitment this year.

AUGUST – SEPTEMBER - OCTOBER

1. The best approach this year is to verify all in the PATONs and Bridges in a single area at a time.
2. Continue encouraging your volunteers to perform their assigned PATON and Bridge verifications and survey.
3. Keep checking every Patrol Area for discrepant ATONs, PATONs and Bridges.
4. Report every "Unauthorized" PATON that you observe to the DSO-NS 013 – Frank Larkin.
5. Reassess your PATON Programs success and progress. Reset your goals as necessary.
6. Encourage your members to think about the Chart Updating and Small Craft Facility programs that are starting up in each Division
 - There are a lot of potential chart corrections available.
 - If you are in an area with a SC Chart, we have SCF projects available.
 - Start your CU Program with the easy projects.

There is still confusion out there as to the AV Tasks for the 2013 Season.

This year, we are tasked to:

- Verify one-third of the scheduled* PATONs.

- Survey all of the bridges in your Patrol Area.
- Check** all of the ATONs.
- Check** all of the unscheduled PATONs.
- Volunteer for your Division CU/SCF Team.

* The PATON verification schedule appears in the Check Off section when you log on to the PATON System as an AV.

** Check the ATONS and unscheduled PATONs while you are in a Patrol Area but only report those aids that are observed with discrepancies to the CG.

Focus your attention on the remaining scheduled PATONs and the Bridges that have not yet been reported!

If you haven't found the PATON Schedule yet, it appears when you log onto the PATON System. See the example below. These are the only PATONs that you need to verify this year.
